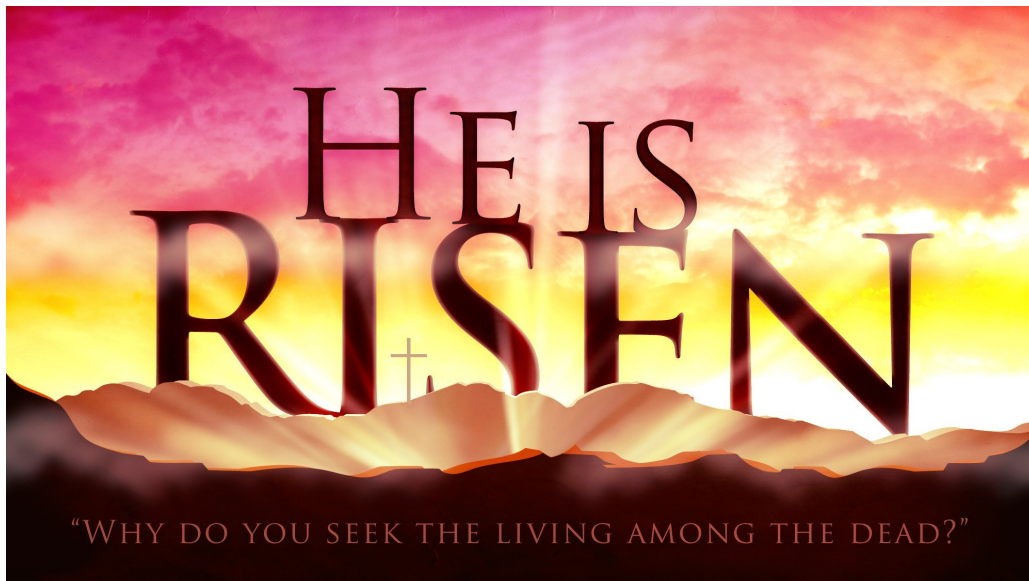
### Post Communion Prayer
