### Collect

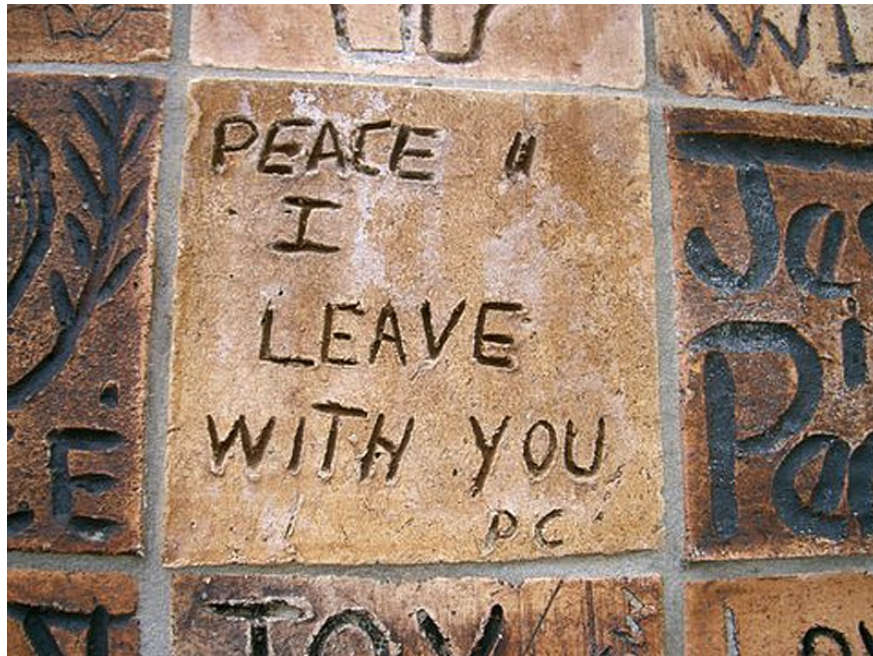
