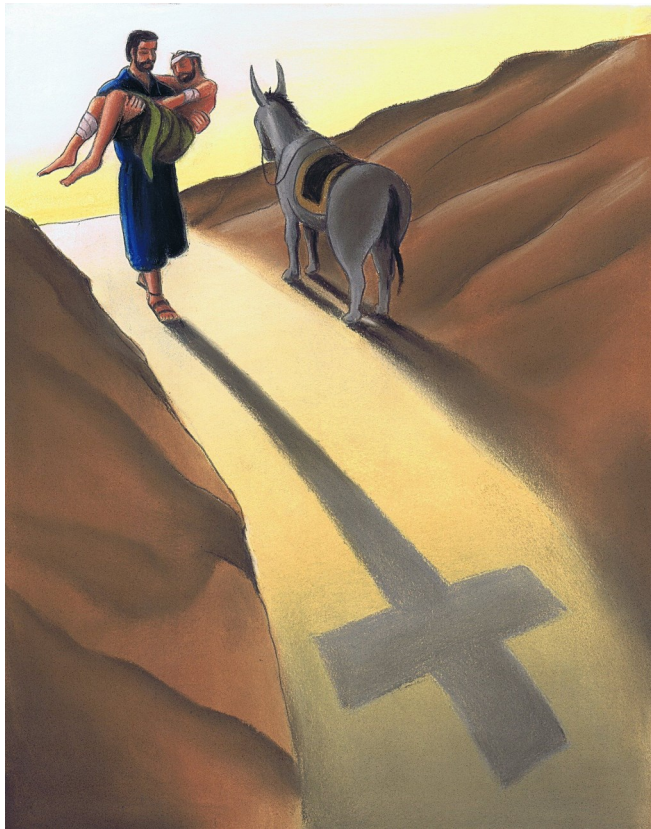
The Fourth Sunday After Trinity (Proper 10)
