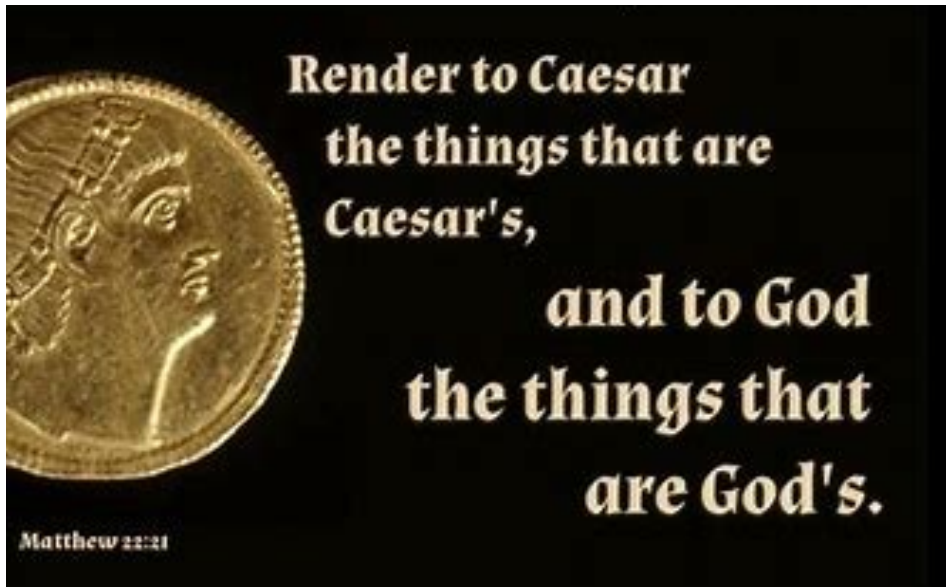
Post Communion
