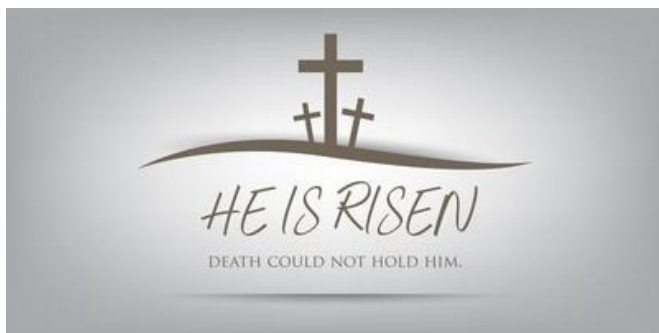

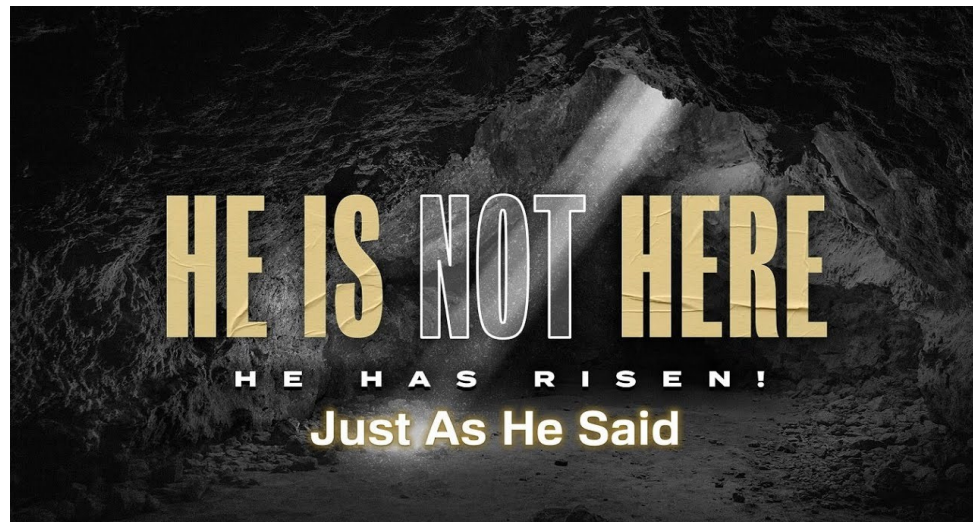
Church Flowers
