Annual Church Meeting

All Church of England parishes must have their two annual meetings somewhere between 1st January and 31st May. The first is 'The Annual Meeting of Parishioners' and elects (or re-elects) the Churchwardens, and will last only minutes.

The second is "The Annual Parochial Church Meeting" or "APCM" and should last for approximately 30 minutes. In this meeting a review of 2023 will take place including the adoption of the accounts and election of four new PCC Members.

If you are on the Electoral Roll you can stand for election to the office of Churchwarden or PCC.
