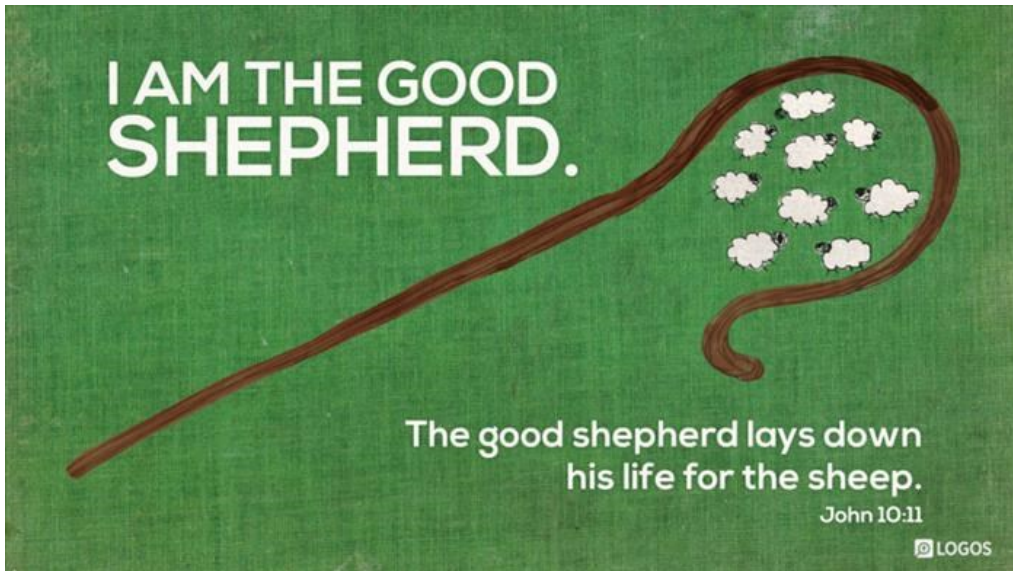
Post Communion
