What is Pentecost?

Pentecost is one of the most significant dates in the Christian calendar and celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit. It takes place on the Sunday 50 days after Easter (the name comes from the Greek pentekoste, "fiftieth").

It is also called Whitsun (White Sunday) and was traditionally a time when baptisms took place with the candidates wearing white. It does not necessarily coincide with the Whitsun Bank Holiday.

Pentecost comes from a Jewish harvest festival called Shavuot. The apostles were celebrating this festival when the Holy Spirit descended on them.

It sounded like a very strong wind, and it looked like tongues of fire. The apostles then found themselves speaking in foreign languages, inspired by the Holy Spirit. People passing by at first thought that they must be drunk, but the apostle Peter told the crowd that the apostles were full of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-21).

Today many people understand Pentecost as being the birthday of the Christian Church.
