

## Organ Works

Bishop & Son (organ builder) will be dismantling sections of the organ next week and taking them back to the workshop for overhauling.

This work is costing almost £30,000 and will take several weeks to complete. Some of this money was raised by our former Fundraising Committee who organised a number of events, including the summer fairs that were held on Church Field. Huge thanks to them.

We are hoping what's left of the organ will be playable, if not we will need to use the piano!

## Contactless Giving

Thank you to those who used the contactless giving machine we borrowed from the Diocese of London. A total of £285 was 'collected' over three Sundays. We have now purchased a contactless giving machine (larger than the one we used in the pilot). This will take two to three weeks to arrive.
