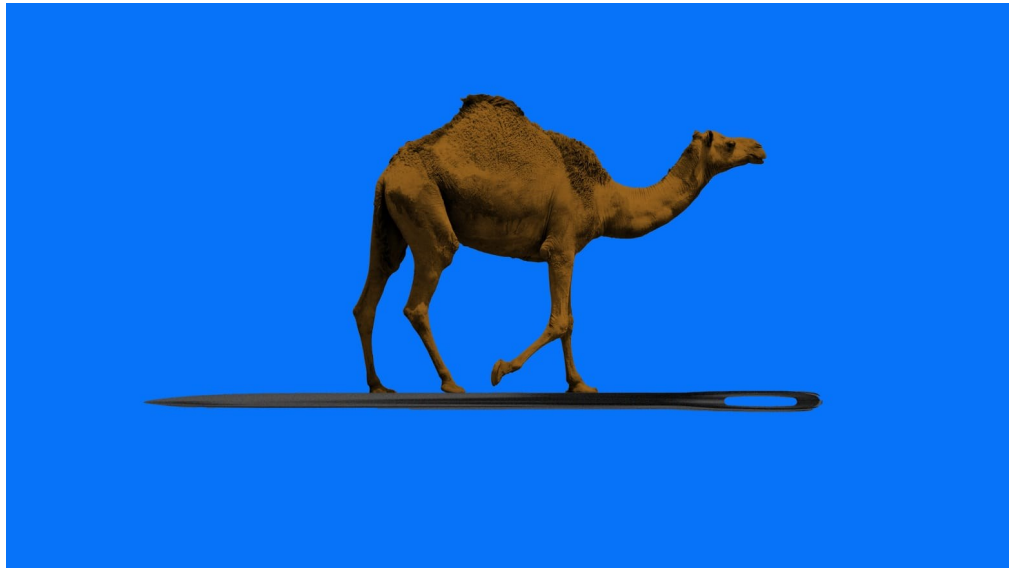
### Post Communion
