
#### Post Communion

### **Electoral Roll Renewal**

In 2025 we need to renew our Electoral Roll (ER). The ER is in effect our church membership list and we would like everyone who attends our services to be on the list.

Once you are on the ER you are eligible to stand for election as a Churchwarden, Deanery Synod Representative and PCC Member - and you have a vote at our church annual meetings later in the year.

Every six years the Church of England renews all Electoral Rolls so we have to take everyone off and start all over again. 2025 is the year!

To join, you have to be over 16 years old, live in the parish and/or attend our services for a minimum of six months. Application forms will be available from 2nd February.

We will also take this opportunity to ask you to complete new GDPR forms which is about how we handle your data. All rather boring but necessary!
