Post Communion

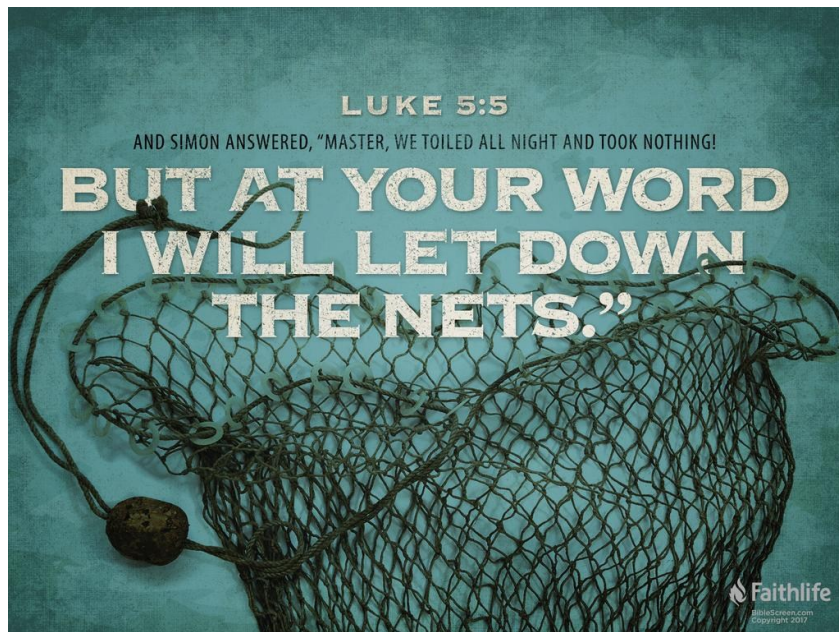
