Post Communion

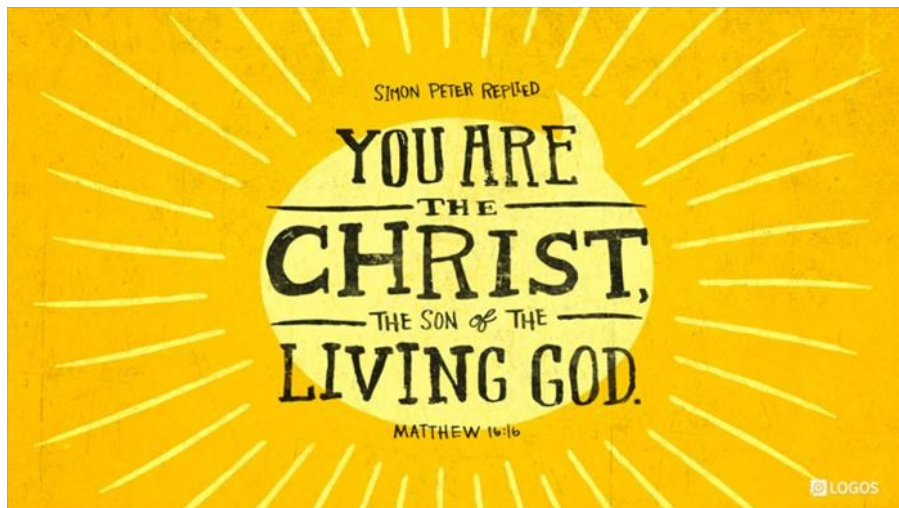
