Harrow Street Pastors Visit

Today we are pleased to welcome a team from the Harrow Street Pastors to speak in the 9.30am Parish Communion about their work in Wealdstone and Harrow.

Street Pastors in the UK are trained Christian volunteers from local churches who patrol town and city centres, typically from 10pm-3am on Fridays and Saturdays.

They offer practical help, a listening ear, and non-judgmental support to vulnerable people, often assisting those affected by alcohol or drugs to reduce crime and improve safety.

Rachel Phillips is taking the service and will interview the Street Pastors.
