Post Communion

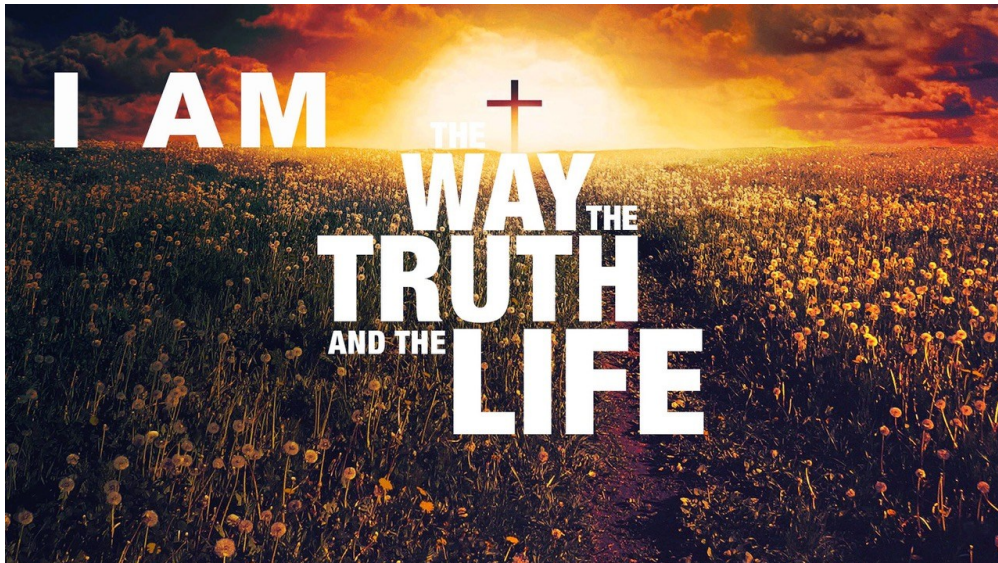
